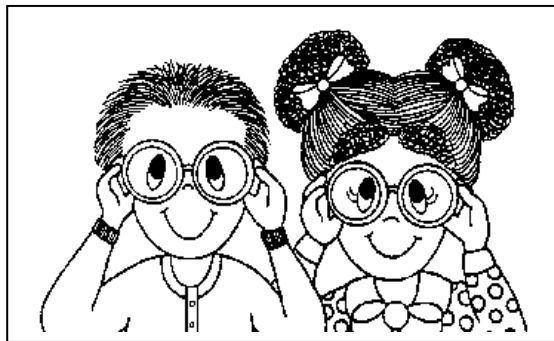

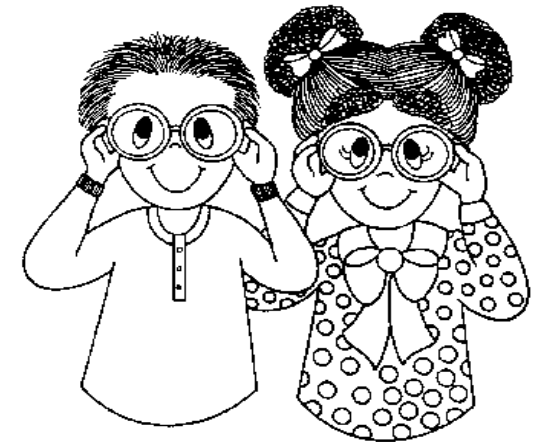

## *Organizational History . . .*

The Clarence J. Carpenter Memorial Fund was established by the St. Joseph Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) in 1937 in memory of Clarence J. Carpenter, former principal of Neely Elementary School, who later served as principal of Bliss Junior High School at the time of his death.

The fund is managed by a volunteer board of 13 members, 9 who are elected by the St. Joseph PTA Council. The other four board members are the St. Joseph PTA Council President, the St. Joseph School District Coordinator of Health Services, and the Missouri PTA Regional Director attached to the PTA Council. The Superintendent of Schools is an advisor to the Board.

The board is also graciously served by two Honorary Trustees: Mrs. Robert (Gertie) Beaver and Mrs. William (Ruth) Mooney, Jr.



## *Guidelines . . .*

Strict guidelines are followed in evaluating each request for financial aid. Students are screened by their school nurse, and referrals are then made through the principal and Coordinator of Health Services for the St. Joseph School District. Each case is considered on an individual basis and records are kept in strict confidence.

## *Purpose . . .*

The primary purpose of the Clarence J. Carpenter Memorial Fund is to provide eye examinations and eyeglasses for students with a proven financial need, after other means have been exhausted. Assistance has also been given for other medical problems such as hearing or dental care. After eligibility is established, students of St. Joseph PTA Council member schools are referred to qualified medical personnel. These professionals generously provide their services to the Carpenter Memorial Fund at reduced rates so that as many children as possible can receive health care.

The object of this fund shall be to provide health and eye care assistance to worthy students of the St. Joseph PTA Council member schools.

The number of students assisted each year shall be governed by the amount of money in the treasury.

### *Students Assisted in 2009/10*

The Clarence J. Carpenter Memorial Fund assisted 92 students with a total of \$9,159 vision expenses during the 2009 - 2010 school year.

## *Funding . . .*

The Clarence J. Carpenter Memorial Fund is supported by contributions from PTA and PTSA units, by memorial and honorary gifts,

and by private donations from individuals, organizations, and business firms.

Each year in January, the "Help a Child to See" funds drive is held within each School District building. It is hoped that all full-time personnel will donate at least \$1 each. If the building has a dollar average equal to 100 percent of the number of full-time employees, then the building employees will receive a certificate of appreciation in February at the PTA Founders' Day Banquet. The "Help a Child to See" campaign is a separate school contribution from the PTA unit donation gifts.
